LITTLE BRICK CHURCH AT DIXON'S CORNERS MARKS CENTENNIAL
1964

The little parish church of St. Anne at Dixon's Corners is one hundred years old. Parishioners marked the centennial on Wednesday, July 29th with a Solemn High Mass and a parish banquet.

St. Anne's church in Dixon's Corners is a mission of South Mountain. Rev. T. G. Scanlon, pastor of this parish-mission in the northeast section of Kingston Archdiocese, celebrated the Mass, assisted by former pastors. Rev. F. J. O'Neill, also a former pastor, preached the sermon at the Mass.

St. Anne's brick church, built in 1864, (a stone above the main doorway carries the date still clearly visible), served the early Irish immigrants who settled in Dundas County. Most of the parishioners were of Irish descent, but it took a wave of Dutch immigrants following World War II to revive the parish as many of the old families had died out and farms became vacant.

At first Dixon's Corners was a mission of Morrisburg. As early as 1849 a church was built at Dixon's Corners, by Father Coyle, who was pastor at Morrisburg. It was a rough cast church and served parishioners until the present church was built in 1864.

Until 1906 Dixon's Corners was a mission of Morrisburg and served by the pastors who lived in that town. The first pastor to take up residence in Morrisburg, was Father Coyle. Father John Meade, former pastor of Lochiel, became resident pastor of Morrisburg in 1856. At this time Kingston Archdiocese took in much of the present Alexandria Diocese.

Father J. Connelly became the next priest in charge of Dixon's Corners. In 1865, Father Connelly resigned because of good health and Father P. Hartigan was placed in charge. Succeeding pastors entrusted with the souls at Dixon's Corners were Rev. Morgan C. O'Brien, Rev. Dennis A. Twomey, Rev. J. P. Fleming, Rev. P. McKiernan and Rev. J. McCarthy.

Father McCarthy left Morrisburg in 1906 and at that time Archbishop Gauthier made Dixon's Corners a mission of Kemptville. But this arrangement lasted only a few weeks. On August 9, 1906 Archbishop Gauthier announced that the two missions, South Mountain and Dixon's Corners were to form a new parish. Dixon's Corners was made the mission.

Pastors were appointed to South Mountain who now took over the care of the souls at Dixon's Corners.

These pastors were: Rev. John Meehan (1907); Rev. Richard O'Farrell (1907-1913); Rev. James Keeley (1913-1917); Rev. S. A. Corrigan (1917-1921); Rev. Eugene O'Sullivan (1921-1925); Rev. E. A. Byrne (1925-1926); Rev. J. S. Ryan (1926-1931); Rev. A. L. O'Donnell & Rev. Harold Rice (1932-1945); Rev. J. E. Trainor, Rev. D. W. MacDonald, Rev. F. J. O'Neill, Rev. J. P. Healey and the present pastor, Rev. T. G. Scanlon.
